### **Guidelines for the Author**

Authors submitting their research articles must follow the guidelines given below:

1. Manuscript should consist of at least 3,500 words and not exceed more than 7,000 words including references.
2. Manuscript should be prepared using Microsoft Word. The text should be left aligned and typed in Times New Roman, 12 font size with double spacing between lines, and 1-inch margins applied in all sides of A4 paper.
3. The abstract should be informative and should not exceed 250 words. It should include objectives, methods, results and conclusion.
4. Following the abstract, 4 to 6 keywords should cover the thematic aspect.
5. APA 7<sup>th</sup> edition should be followed.
6. Authors are required to send their manuscript in word.docx and PDF format through email to [journals@fwu.edu.np](mailto:journals@fwu.edu.np).
7. To facilitate the blind review process, authors' name should not appear anywhere in the manuscript or in the filename. Author's name, designation and institutional address should be in a separate file.
8. Authors are requested to check manuscript for accuracy of language before submitting to the journal. The Editorial Board will not edit submitted manuscripts for style or language.
9. Manuscript submitted must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere, either in electronic or printed form. The corresponding author should declare this when submitting the paper to the Editorial Board.
10. The Editorial Board reserves the right to make editorial changes to any manuscript accepted for publication to enhance clarity and style.
11. Author should mention clearly DOIs and persistent links to those references that have DOIs.
12. Copyright for articles published in this journal are retained by the authors, with first publication right granted to the publisher.
13. The publisher is not responsible for subsequent uses of the work. It is the author's responsibility to bring an infringement action if so desired by the author.
